



On-board camera licencing VLN season 2017

On-board cameras in general

The mere use of on-board camera systems, for instance for subsequent analyses of driving situations, does not require a licence in VLN. Please make sure, however, that the camera is mounted properly and approved by the VLN technical scrutineering.

Publication of on-board recordings (for instance: team website, YouTube etc.)

Licencing is required for the publication of any kind of on-board recording. As part of this licencing process, it will be checked what kind of publication (non-commercial or commercial) is intended and whether a fee is payable for the licencing. The corresponding licence form will be provided on www.vln.de in the next few days.

Live on-board camera

VLN provides an official live on-board camera system. Only through this system is it allowed to not only stream locally (for instance to the pit, hospitality etc.) but also on the internet (for instance: YouTube, Facebook etc.). An info sheet about the official VLN live on-board camera system will be provided on www.vln.de in the next few days.

Unofficial live on-board camera systems

The use of unofficial live on-board camera systems requires a licence. This licencing is subject to a fee. Due to limited network resources, only a limited number of live on-board cameras can be approved. In addition, unofficial live on-board camera systems may only be used to stream locally (for instance: hospitality, lounge, pit etc.). Streaming of live images on the internet is not permitted. The corresponding licence form will be provided on www.vln.de in the next few days.
